Notes to EMPLOYERS Regarding Unemployment



American Job Centers across Tennessee are limiting public access due to COVID-19. At this time, all Unemployment Claims must be submitted online or with phone support.

American Job Center staff are still available to assist customers by phone. Contact numbers can be found at www.NWTNJobs.org/locations.

STEP 1 FOR ALL EMPLOYERS: Visit www.tn.gov/workforce and click on "Employers."

You will have 2 options based on the following question:

HAS LAYOFF ALREADY OCCURRED?

LAYOFF HAS <u>NOT YET</u> OCCURRED

If the layoff <u>has not</u> yet occurred, and you believe you will reopen / bring employees back, complete the **Employer-Filed Mass Claim** form, <u>before</u> the layoff occurs, and submit it to <u>Partial.Claims@tn.gov</u>.

* Instruct employees <u>not</u> to file an individual claim. They will need to certify each Sunday to be paid in a timely manner.

LAYOFF <u>HAS</u> ALREADY OCCURRED

If the layoff <u>has already</u> occurred, complete a **Mass Layoff Form** and submit it to Mass.Layoff@tn.gov.
